I personally could not miss the opportunity to counsel many during my treatment and lead them to Christ. Although the medicine was not enough to treat thousands of patients, Shirley did her best to dispense it to the most disabled or sick first. In fact, Shirley worked diligently to make sure all of the patients got the medicines they needed. Needless to say, Linda worked day and

night to order all the medicines for these endemic diseases and to organize the mission. She was a good model for Christ among them.

As a result of our mission, the church was packed on Sunday. More came to listen to our message, and

many people accepted Christ as their saviour. We spent a few days in the village of Kereo where poverty, sickness, and misfortune is prevalent. We took with us about twenty large boxes of medicine and dental supplies to Romania worth \$150,000. We used about seven boxes in this village only. However, I was thrilled and praised the Lord when I saw hundreds of people come forward after the message to accept the Lord as their Savior.
